

I'm going to the library

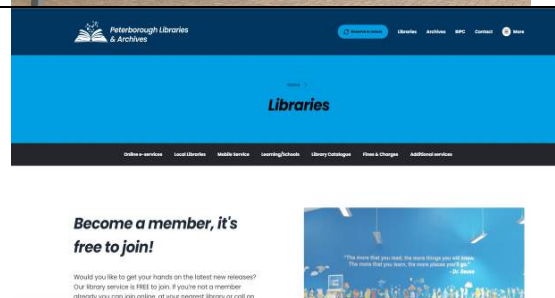


Before I go to the library

I'm going to Hampton Library. Hampton Library can be found inside Hampton Library and Leisure Centre. To get to the library, I will need to go through the main doors of the leisure centre and past the reception desk to the library door on the left. I can ask at the leisure centre reception desk if I need help to find the library.

This is what I will see as I come into the library. I can go through the door into the library.



About the library

There are people who work at the library who I can talk to.



The library is usually a quiet place where people talk quietly, relax and read books. Sometimes, there are activities going on that make it a little noisier.



If I am looking for children's books, I can go to the children's area by going past the staff desk and over towards the left when I enter the library.



How I become a member of the library

When I go into the library, I will be able to see a staff desk in front of me to the right.



I can talk to someone who works there to become a member of the library.



I will show them identification. This can be a driving licence, bank statement, household bill or something else with my address on, plus something with my name and date of birth on, such as a passport or birth certificate.



I will also tell them my email address and telephone number. The staff member will enter my information into the computer, this makes me a member of the library and I will be given a library card. I will also be able to set a special PIN for my card, this is like a password for my account.



When I visit the library

In the library there will be shelves of fiction books, non-fiction and audio books.



I can sit in a chair to read a book. There are also tables where I can read or study.



I can borrow up to 12 books and take them home with me. I can use the self-service kiosks to borrow the books.



If I need help to borrow books, or with anything else, I will talk to a member of the library staff. I can go to the staff desk to find a member of staff at any time.



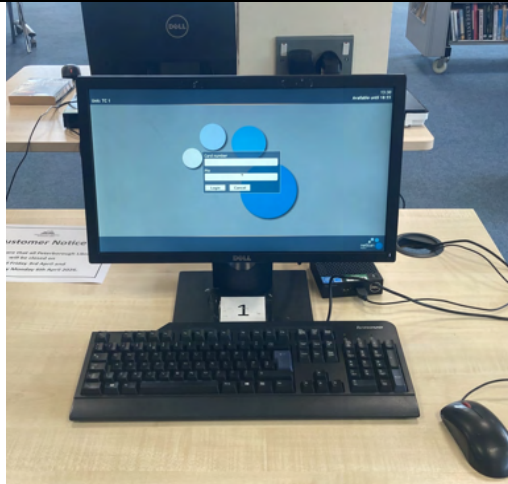
The library will also have some computers.



The computers are free to use for two hours per day.



To use the computers I may need to wait until one is free. I will need to enter my library card number and my PIN. If I need help logging onto the computers, I can ask the library staff.



When I have finished I will leave the library.
